Blouberg Beach



Bloubergstrand / is a suburb of Cape Town along the shores of Table Bay, about 25 km to the north of the city centre of Cape Town. The name Bloubergstrand literally means "blue mountain beach" in Afrikaans, and is derived from Blaauwberg, a nearby mountain. Bloubergstrand is mainly a residential area, and attracts a large numbers of visitors. The beach at Bloubergstrand is a popular location for a classic view of Table Mountain across the bay. Robben Island is located 6,9 km west of the coast of Bloubergstrand.

The tasting room's décor is chic, inviting you to linger in the lounge area with its comfy, contemporary seating or outside amidst the Renosterveld garden and taste the range of wines on their own or paired with either chocolate or biltong. The comfortable lounge furniture is the perfect setting for sipping on a glass of crisp Sauvignon Blanc.

Durbanville Hills restaurant offers the perfect environment from which to escape the hustle and bustle of city-life. The light and contemporary space with a double volume ceiling, wood finishes, earthy tones and South African décor, offers panoramic views of Table Mountain, Table Bay, the rolling hills and vineyards. The wooden deck is the perfect setting for sipping on a glass of crisp Sauvignon Blanc whilst the kids are entertained in the play-area.
